We can't believe another year has passed, and what a year it has been.

Park

Although the year had its many trials and difficulties, it's one of the best things that has happened to our area, as it gave us the opportunity and time to clear and clean our beautiful park.

Thank you to all those involved in the arduous task. It's great to see so many people using the park, and once the COVID restrictions and dangers are over, we hope to have fun events and use it even more. During December the padlock on the pedestrian gate will be removed between 06h30 and 18h30 daily.

Security upgrades

During this year the following was installed on the palisade fences (weak points) in our area:

Flame Crescent - 7 cameras (with 24 hour surveillance), 7 spot-lights, new cabling for beams, new full length electric fence, code-access controlled pedestrian gate.

Dickie Fritz - 8 cameras were recently installed between the Moth Hall and the bridge in Dickie Fritz Avenue. The River Ridge committee installed cameras from the bridge up to the first house in that area. So the whole of the palisade fence adjacent to the open veld next to the freeway is now under 24 hour camera surveillance. The Glades, and Green Park complexes are contributing to the rental and monitoring of some of these cameras.

CPF Camera

We still have the active CPF camera at the boom which is linked to SAP and CPFC and is part of the greater initiative monitoring stolen vehicles, cloned numbers and false registration numbers.

Contributions

Thank you to all who have continued to pay their monthly security fees during this difficult year. Your consistent payments are why we can make the necessary needed upgrades.

Collection for the Guards

Firstly, thank you so much to Chantelle who co-ordinated the collection again this year. Secondly thank you to all those that contributed. The total collected was R15 600, split between the 6 guards - each received R2600.
