Crime Incidents

We are happy to say that whilst the crime statistics in other areas have increased significantly recently, our area had been crime free.

According to 24/7 Security, vehicles targeted recently are Porsche, Range Rovers, and other high end vehicles. Of course these vehicles are not exclusively at risk - anyone can be a target.

It appears that suspects have spotters in local shops/centres who look for jewellery/cash whilst you are shopping, and pass the information to their accomplices who either park outside the mall or wait nearby. Unsuspecting people are then followed home and robbed in their driveways.

Please be vigilant at all times. Be alert when driving - at all times. If there is an unfamiliar vehicle in the vicinity of your home when you come home, rather drive around the block first before entering your driveway.

Personal Responsibility

Please don't take living in a boomed area as a guarantee of your safety. You are still responsible for your own alarm, electric fencing, beams etc. If you need an alarm system, please contact 24/7. If possible, please don't park cars on your pavement, as this may attract criminals to the area.
