As you are all aware, the bridge was badly damaged by the recent floods. We are in the process of erecting a temporary fence, as the council need to perform structural repairs before we can replace the permanent palisade.

## Annual License fee

The annual ICASA licence fee of R186 per household has been paid on your behalf by the road closure's accumulated funds.

## Booms

During December, the middle island at the booms will be widened, and the sensor that is activated by the guard to open the boom will be moved to the island. This will mean that the guard will have clear visibility into cars entering and exiting the area as the drivers swipe the sensor.
